Agreement of 25% pay forward to Education is Power (EIP) from EIP post-secondary graduates:

Effective from the agreements made in an EIP meeting February 24, 2013 at the KENVO resource centre in Kimende, Kenya, all post-secondary graduates of EIP will pay back 25% of all their donations they received through EIP.

This contract must be signed by all EIP post-secondary students in order for them to continue to be a student of EIP.

The money will be used to support future EIP students thus making EIP more sustainable. **The EIP committee believes that 25% is not a large amount for students to pay back so this is only a suggested minimum amount. Paying forward more than 25% and/or volunteering time to help EIP is strongly encouraged for EIP to be able to continue and prosper.**

Terms of Agreement

I, _____, acknowledge that I am a post-secondary student who has been supported financially by *Education is Power*. I agree to pay forward 25% of all money received by me from *Education is Power* in a five year period starting on my graduation. It is understood that payments will only be made while I am employed on a full time basis after graduation, and therefore the five year term will be suspended during any time(s) of unemployment after graduation.

The agreement is not retroactive but it applies to all money paid out by EIP to me after February 24, 2013 according to the minutes of an *Education is Power* meeting in Kimende, Kenya.
